- \$50 per year or \$80 for two years. Will be due upon last mentored class.

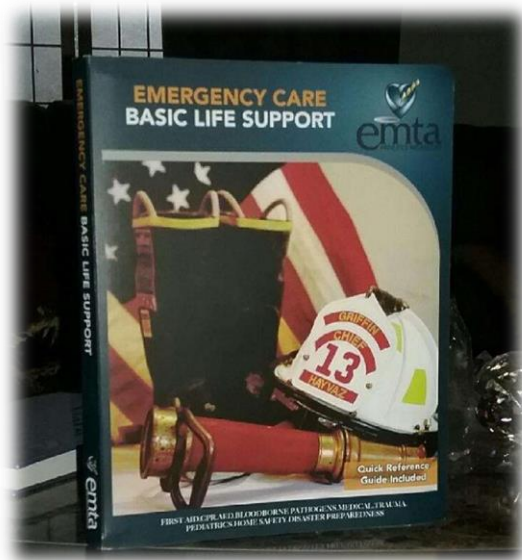
Instructor Agreement:
